

# **Plainfield Friends Church Quaker Day Festival Saturday, October 4, 2008**

Dear Festival Vendor:

Quaker Day will be sponsored again this year by Plainfield Friends Church. This year's date is October 4, 2008. We hope that you will consider participating in this exciting event. We have enclosed an extra application for you to share with a friend. Many thanks to those vendors who have helped make this a successful event for so many years.

This marks the 22nd year that our festival will be held on the beautiful, shaded lawn of the Plainfield Friends Church at the southeast corner of US 40 and East Street near downtown Plainfield. The craft fair will begin at 9:00 am and end at approximately 4:00 pm. Quaker Day also includes a community parade in the morning (which draws visitors from many area communities) and pork chop dinners served to several hundred.

Booth spaces are approximately 15' x 15' and locations will be assigned on a first come/first served basis on festival day. The deadline for reservations is September 29, 2008. Set up time on the day of the event will begin at 7:30 am. You must supply all of your own materials such as tables, chairs, electricity, etc. The Church reserves the right to refuse any vendor whose product or presentation conflicts with our traditional Quaker/Christian Testimonies or beliefs. Plainfield Friends Meeting, its membership, or representatives may not be held responsible for theft, accidents, or any other loss associated with this event.

*You will be contacted only if your application is **not** accepted.*

*No ready-to-eat food or beverages are to be sold on church grounds except by Plainfield Friends Church. This includes bake sale articles. (Food designed to be prepared and consumed later, such as cookie mix or spice packets, may be sold.)*

**Rain or shine, the festival will be held with no refunds.**

*The cost of each 15' x 15' booth space is \$25.00 with an advance reservation. Space rented on festival day will be \$35.00. Without advance reservations, availability can not be guaranteed on festival day.*
